Re: Dkt. No. 83

On November 12, 2024, the district court referred all discovery disputes to the undersigned, including the pending joint discovery letter pertaining to Plaintiffs' Requests for Production of Documents (Set One) (Dkt. No. 83). The joint discovery letter does not, however, comply with the format and page limits set forth in the Court's standing order, which makes it difficult to efficiently resolve the dispute. Accordingly, the pending joint letter is TERMINATED, and the parties are ordered to meet and confer in an attempt to resolve the pending dispute without court intervention.
